

Proposed CLARIN Community Session "Standard Community of practice"

Abstract

One of the main goals of the CLARIN Standards Committee (CSC) is to build a system of interoperable resources and to monitor the use of standards within the European research infrastructure consortium CLARIN. The infrastructure is based on several CLARIN centres that have been externally evaluated. CLARIN centres commit themselves to the goals of interoperability and sustainability of data. In reaching these aims, the use of standards plays an important role to reach these aims. For this purpose the CLARIN Board of Directors established the CSC.

In the proposed session the CSC will present its approaches to both providing information about de-jure and de-facto standards and convincing the CLARIN centres to make use of designated standards for specific tasks. Moreover, we would like to discuss the different standards used in the CLARIN community. Since DARIAH is also very interested in the use of standards, the session could also serve as a starting point for more joint activities of CLARIN and DARIAH.
